Attention Information Service Representatives (ISRs)

- Prior to attending your first meeting, give AISDV your contact information, your group name, and your district number. This will ensure that you receive agenda, minutes, and reports prior to meetings. All meetings are on Zoom; try to arrive a little early as it helps with roll call. All Zoom meetings begin at 7:30 PM.
- When you attend the Zoom meeting, add to the Chat: your first name, last name initial, group name, district #, and Y or N to indicate whether you will be voting on behalf of your group. This will speed up roll call for attendance and voting requirements. AISDV meetings can be long and we are trying to find ways to save time. You don't have to be an ISR to attend the meeting, but everyone must add their info to the Chat so AISDV can record attendance and quorum.

Responsible Stewardship

November is an important month in the AISDV calendar. Nominations and elections take place for service positions that are due for rotation, and the budget for the following year is presented and approved.

In 2024, AISDV's increased level of activity has meant more income and more spending than in 2023. Donations have been strong all year, and fundraising has been successful. I anticipate that the 2025 budget for the Vice Chair (fundraising), Public Outreach, Sponsored Events and the PA Area Liaison will grow in 2025. We will also propose increasing the rent we pay to the 4021 Clubhouse, both because we are using their WiFi, and because the rent has remained constant for years, and an increase is due.

The proposed budget will not become final until approved by the voting members of the AISDV (that's you, ISRs!). Responsible stewardship means that you will ask questions to clarify your understanding, offer constructive suggestions and vote as part of the group conscience. Please be sure to attend the November 21 meeting and participate in this important discussion and decision. AISDV is counting on you!

AISDV Still Needs a Secretary

AISDV has been without a Secretary for over 10 months creating challenges for everyone participating in the work of this service arm. An AISDV Secretary maintains contact information, takes minutes of meetings, notifies attendees of meetings, and provides attendees with reports and other info they need for meetings. Any member of Al-Anon in the AISDV service area, who is not also a member of AA, is eligible for the position. The position of Assistant Secretary is also open.

LITERATURE COORDINATOR CORNER

No matter who you are or where you are on your journey with Al-Anon, there is conference approved literature that can be of service to you. There are bookmarks, pamphlets, and daily readers. There are also in depth books addressing many of life's challenges and triumphs.

Al-Anon's "Daily Checklist of Myself" (S-6) was written with Alateens in mind, but it's a great tool for anyone! It's a two-sided single page. The front side titled "Daily Checklist of Myself" is sub-headed "Step Ten: Continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong promptly admitted it." This is followed by "Just For Today, I will take my own inventory." On this front side is a checklist with 13 questions, each tied to a slogan, step, or principle; along with check boxes for every day of the week.

For example:

- Q: "Did I worry or over react?" is tied to "Let Go and Let God" (S, M, T, W, T, F, S)
- Q: "Did I indulge in self pity?" is tied to "Everyone has problems, together we can make it; meetings help." (S, M, T, W, T, F, S)

The back side is titled "How Am I Doing?" It contains a list of 16 attitudes or behaviors and a space to write which program tools are helping you change. Below that, there is a space to write "Other Things That I'm Working on Changing."
