This Month's Step, Tradition, and Concept

Step 2: Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.

Tradition 2: For our group purpose there is but one authority—a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our leaders are but trusted servants—they do not govern.

Concept 2: The Al-Anon Family Groups have delegated complete administrative and operational authority to their Conference and its service arms.



Tradition 2: This program of recovery has been one of the greatest gifts of my life. Growing up in a home with alcoholism, I learned that there was one authority, my father, and I lived in fear of displeasing him. In Alateen/Al-Anon, and through the grace of my Higher Power, I've learned to move through my fear and to value being in a group which values participation and recognizes that leadership comes from each of us.

Through the nudging of my Higher Power through the people in these rooms, I will be embracing the service opportunity of RAP Coordinator beginning March 2025. As each of us are equals and

 - Al-Anon tools and resources that have worked for you, i.e. slogans, literature, etc.
 - How have you grown in service? Was there anything that held you back from committing to service?

- PLEASE arrive early to Zoom meetings to help with roll call. Zoom meetings begin at 7:30 PM.
- When you attend the Zoom meeting, PLEASE add to the Chat: your first name, last name initial, group name, district #, and Y or N to indicate whether you will be voting on behalf of your group.

This will speed up roll call for attendance and voting requirements. AISDV meetings can be long. You can help shorten them. You don't have to be an ISR to attend the meeting, but everyone must add their info to the Chat so AISDV can record attendance and quorum.
